# Cy-Fair FFA Requirements

- ❖ **Your scramble calf must be kept within a 10 mile radius of Cy-Fair High School.**
  - The reason for this is the Ag. Teachers will visit the projects once a week and will need to be able see all the projects in a reasonable amount of time.
- ❖ **Parent/student must have away to pull a trailer to transport your calf to and from validation, prospect/progress shows, and to the Houston Livestock Show.**
- ❖ The place where you keep your project must have:
  - Running water, you will be water and wash your animal daily
  - A good shelter, for both hot and cold weather,
  - Flood free zone, for the animal and for you to get to the animal
  - Electricity
  - A pasture where you can turn your project out to graze and exercise

# Calf Scramble & the school barn

- Only steers will be allowed to be kept at the school barn **if there is room**
- We will not know if there is room for your steer until **ALL** CFISD animals have moved in. (October)
- You must be able to find a place to keep your steer from at least May/June to October.
  - If there is no room at the district barn you will have to keep your steer offsite the entire duration of the project (May/June 2020 to March 2021)

# HLSR Requirements

- ❖ Between the ages of 14-17
- ❖ Student must weigh 100 pounds
- ❖ Student must be eligible (passing all classes) on the day of their assigned scramble.
- ❖ Applicant must be financially able to supply any additional funds needed to purchase, feed and care for the project.
- ❖ Applicant and his/her parents must be willing and the participant must be eligible to spend the required time away from school and other activities to exhibit and care for the heifer or steer.
- ❖ If the student is unable to show due to ineligibility, the student will be required to re-pay the value of the scramble certificate.
- ❖ Complete Quality Counts Certification

- Feed bucket: About \$20
  - Hay rack/bag: \$10-40
  - Rope halter: \$5
  - Show halter: \$45
  - Show stick: \$25-35
  - Neck sweat: \$45
  - Beet pulp: \$17.99
  - Supplements: \$40-50
  - Joint supplements: \$80-110
  - Shampoo and conditioner: \$12
  - Wormer: \$20-60
  - Brushes: \$5-10
  - Show comb: \$12
- Total : \$400.00+/-

# How much time will it take?

## Total of 10 months or 300+/- days

This includes all of summer break, Thanksgiving Break, Christmas Break, and Spring Break.

- Your project will need to be washed, dried, and conditioned at least every other day, especially if you have a heifer.
  - Summer hours:
    - Every morning: at least 2 hours
    - Every night: at least 3 hours
  - School hours:
    - Every morning: about 30 minutes
    - Every night: at least 3-4 hours





# Purchase Certificate Rules

- ❖ Receive \$2,250 certificate
  - \$1,750 used to purchase the project
  - \$500 will be received after the banquet at the 2021 show
- ❖ Must own steers by June 30th, 2020 and Heifers by September 1st, 2020 - AST (Ag. Science Teacher) must approve this purchase
- ❖ Winners cannot purchase animals from:
  - themselves
  - immediate family members (mother, father, brother, sister, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, grandfather, grandmother, stepfather, stepmother, half-brother, half-sister, niece, nephew, aunt, uncle, cousin)
  - immediate family members ranches (family ranches or partnerships)
  - their 4-H/FFA advisor or 4-H club/FFA chapter.
- ❖ Winners may not purchase heifers that have been previously exhibited through any Calf Scramble program. Payments will not be issued to 4-H Clubs, FFA Chapters, students, parents or supervisors.




