Rabbits

- Cost:

- Rabbits (trio)= \$300-\$500
- Supplies= \$200
- Housing (build or buy)= \$200
- Feed= \$100
- Total: about \$800- \$1000 to buy and care for a trio rabbits

- Key information

- Breeding rabbits are bought from breeder, you do not sell them
- Market Rabbits are babies of breeder rabbits or babies you buy
 - You sell these
- Rabbits must be kept at your house
